- **Annual Meeting:** The Annual meeting held each spring is the optimal networking opportunity for professionals involved with Animal Transportation. (Members wishing to list their company names, branches, and corporate contacts/websites must utilize the Corporate or Small Business Membership categories.)
- The individual is recognized as the only contact within the organization, is the only name listed in the Directory and Resources Guide, and is the only person to receive the weekly e-newsletter and other information disseminated by ATA
