Cargolux Implements Screening Fee in Canada

Luxembourg, 15 June 2021

Dear Partners,

In accordance with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) air cargo security standard and Transport Canada regulations, effective **June 30th, 2021** all shipments accepted for air transport from or in Canada by Cargolux Airlines will be required to be screened prior to transportation.

Cargolux Airlines will be applying a Screening Fee for all cargo delivered unscreened requiring screening to be performed by Cargolux Airlines and/or its authorized agent.

The applicable Screening Fee will be **CAD 0.11 per kilo** charged based on the Airwaybill Chargeable Weight and will be invoiced as a Due Carrier Fee.
