

## **Endre Sós, DVM, PhD, Dipl. ECZM (Zoo Health Management)**

Dr. Sós graduated at the University of Veterinary Science in Budapest in 1995 and started as a zoo veterinarian in the same year at the Budapest Zoo and Botanical Garden. He became the Head of the Veterinary and Conservation Department in 2003, and currently the Director of Veterinary Services and Conservation. He and his team are the official veterinarians in numerous conservation programs, dealing with the Hungarian meadow viper, Imperial Eagle and endangered rodents of Hungary and also in charge of the largest wildlife hospital in Hungary, treating 1500-2000 patients every year. He is one of the vet advisors in the Elephant TAG, Old World Monkey TAG, Przewalski's horse EEP and Red panda EEP. He is the Vice-Chairman of the Hungarian Association of Zoo and Wildlife Veterinarians (EAZWV Hungarian Section), completed a PhD in Great Bustard medicine and became a Diplomate of the European College of Zoological Medicine (Zoo Health Management) in 2012. Dr. Sós was also elected as the Vice-Chair of the EAZWV (European Association of Zoo and Wildlife Veterinarians) in October, 2018.
